Membership Categories »

Employer Members

Eligibility» Employer Members manage disability, risk, workers’ compensation, absence, safety, health or wellness functions exclusively for their own employees.

SMALL EMPLOYER MEMBERSHIP » \$195/year

Definition: A public or privately held organization, or public entity with 1,000 or fewer total (collective) employees, inclusive of all branches, divisions and offices, regardless of geographical region.

MID-SIZED EMPLOYER MEMBERSHIP » \$395/year

Definition: A public or privately held organization, or public entity with between 1,001 and 10,000 total (collective) employees, inclusive of all branches, divisions, and offices, regardless of geographical region.

LARGE EMPLOYER MEMBERSHIP » \$495/year

Definition: A public or privately held company, organization, or public entity with 10,001 or more total (collective) employees, inclusive of all branches, divisions, and offices, regardless of geographical region.

INTERNATIONAL EMPLOYER MEMBERSHIP » \$95/year

Definition: A company, regardless of size, that is headquartered outside of the U.S. and/or Canada, and that is not dominant in their field within the U.S. Marketplace.

Other Member Categories

STUDENT MEMBERSHIP » \$20/year

Student Membership is available to full-time students of colleges, universities and other educational institutions as well as part-time students working toward a degree, with emphasis in the human resource, healthcare, risk management, and related fields. To be eligible for Student Membership, an applicant must, 1) Be enrolled in a minimum of six (6) semester credit hours, and, 2) Submit to DMEC proof of enrollment in academic courses prior to membership acceptance. Supplier Members

Eligibility» Supplier Members serve employers by providing health, absence, insurance, and productivity related programs, services and strategies.

ASSOCIATE SUPPLIER MEMBERSHIP » \$299/year

Definition: A company or organization, including but not limited to, sole proprietors, independent consultants and practitioners, and small, independently-owned businesses, with 50 or fewer employees or sub-contractors inclusive of all branches, divisions and offices, regardless of geographical region.

CORPORATE SUPPLIER MEMBERSHIP » \$699/year

Definition: A company or organization that is an international and/or national supplier of products and/or services to the human resource, healthcare, and/or risk management industry (that is, DMEC Employer Members).

INTERNATIONAL SUPPLIER MEMBERSHIP » \$199/year

Definition: A supplier, regardless of size, that is headquartered outside of the U.S. and/or Canada, and that is not dominant in its field within the U.S. Marketplace.

Definition: A sustaining member is a company of any size that wishes to support the programs and mission of DMEC above and beyond the simple membership. Sustaining members receive additional benefits in terms of visibility and exposure.
